Mel Gibson is back behind the camera with his most Mellish movie yet: a gory WWII battlefield drama marked by issues of faith and sacrifice. *Hacksaw Ridge* is based on the real-life story of Desmond Doss (Andrew Garfield), a fiercely religious conscientious objector who nonetheless managed to save an estimated 75 lives during the Battle of Okinawa. It's sincere, raw and provocative material, perfectly suited to Gibson's directorial

strengths, which are often overlooked.

What could go wrong?

There's a reason why those strengths are often overlooked: Are audiences ready to forgive Gibson? He's expressed remorse for his verbal indiscretions.

Objective Pronouns in Daily Life

Every day, we use objective pronouns without even thinking about them. These pronouns help us avoid repeating names and make sentences sound more natural. For example, instead of saying "I saw Anna and I talked to Anna," we can say, "I saw Anna and I talked to her."

Imagine this: Sarah has a dog. She loves it and takes it for a walk every morning. Her neighbors often greet her and say hello to her dog too. One of the neighbors, Jake, always brings treats. Sarah thanks him and says, "My dog really likes you!"

Objective pronouns make conversation easier and clearer. We use them when the pronoun is the object of a verb or preposition. So, next time you say a sentence like “She called me,” remember: “me” is an objective pronoun!
