Mel Gibson is back behind the camera with his most Mellish movie yet: a gory WWII battlefield drama marked by issues of faith and sacrifice. *Hacksaw Ridge* is based on the real-life story of Desmond Doss (Andrew Garfield), a fiercely religious conscientious objector who nonetheless managed to save an estimated 75 lives during the Battle of Okinawa. It's sincere, raw and provocative material, perfectly suited to Gibson's directorial overlooked

strengths, which are often overlooked.

What could go wrong?

There's a reason why those strengths are often overlooked: Are audiences ready to forgive Gibson? He's expressed remorse for his verbal indiscretions.
