The Earth is the third planet from the Sun and is the place we call home. It is a special planet in the Solar System because it is the only one where life exists. The surface of the Earth is made up of land and water. Land takes up roughly one-third (1/3) of the planet's surface area. The land is divided into large sections called continents, which are America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Oceania, and Antarctica. Water, which includes oceans, seas, lakes, and rivers, makes up about two-thirds (2/3) of the planet. There are five oceans on Earth: the Pacific, the Atlantic, the Indian, the Arctic, and the Southern Ocean.
